We are seeking a Field Operator to join our Field Operations team at our Waterton Gas Plant. This is a hands-on field role where you'll work in outdoor, remote environments, navigate varying weather and terrain, and participate in on-call and rotational schedules to support 24/7 operations. If you bring strong mechanical aptitude, solid field operations experience, and a commitment to safety, this is a great opportunity to join a collaborative, high-performing team.

Key Responsibilities

Operations Integrity & Production Monitoring

- Monitor and control production operations using SCADA, HMI, and field inspections.
- Perform routine well and equipment checks, verifying pressures, temperatures, flows, tank levels, and compressor performance.
- Execute normal and emergency start-up, shutdown, and isolation procedures.
- Support troubleshooting with maintenance, engineering, and planning teams.
- Enter work notifications in Maximo; complete PMs, logs, and operational documentation.
- Submit production-related reporting and participate in daily hazard and job assessments.

Production Optimization & Technical Support

- Identify and communicate optimization opportunities to improve production, run time, and reliability.
- Monitor well performance trends and report anomalies.

- Support chemical program management and sampling/testing programs.
- Collaborate with engineering on production enhancement initiatives and field trials.

Equipment Operation

- Operate valves, compressors, pumps, separators, tanks, pig launchers/receivers, and other production equipment.
- Perform minor safe maintenance tasks when authorized.
- Conduct inspections to identify leaks, corrosion, vibration, noise, and equipment deterioration.

Environmental Compliance & Stewardship

- Conduct environmental inspections—emissions, venting, flaring, spills, and waste handling.
- Ensure compliance with AER regulations and Cavvy ESG policies.
- Complete documentation for spills, releases, and exceedances.
- Follow procedures for wildlife protection, watercourse management, and sensitive areas.

Execution of Safe Work Practices

- Prepare and review Work Control Certificates.
- Support safe execution of field work, including blind sheets, carseals, safeguard overrides, and safety equipment inspections.
- Report hazards, HAZIDs, and near misses in Maximo.
- Participate in safety meetings, inspections, and high-potential job discussions.

Emergency Response

- Maintain knowledge of the Complex ERP and assigned emergency roles.
- Respond to emergency conditions and activate ESD/USD systems when required.
- Monitor fire, LEL, and H₂S detection systems and take corrective actions.
